"It feels like we are living in a bubble," smiles Mai. "Everyone is very friendly and welcoming which makes me feel like it is the 1950s all over again."







Canadian born and current resident of Fair Oaks, Kendrick has devoted his life to bringing world-class music to Sacramento residents! Kendrick is the founding Conductor of the Sacramento Choral Society and Orchestra (SCSO) and Director of Music at Sacred Heart Church.

For over 30 years, Kendrick has conducted world-class concert performances in the Greater Sacramento Area and all around the world, venues including Carnegie Hall, The Vatican, Notre Dame, and the Great Wall of China – just to name a few!


After retiring as Director of Music at Sacramento State in 2018, Kendrick decided it was time to take a more active role in the community – specifically focusing on underserved communities where music programs are typically underfunded or cut entirely. In 2019, Kendrick and SCSO President, Jim McCormick, chased after small and large donations to fund SCSO's annual "Children's Holiday Matinee Concert" Outreach Program at Sacramento Memorial Auditorium on December 6. This program is unlike any other in Sacramento – as SCSO completely funds the transportation and ticket cost to over 2000 students in the Greater Sacramento Area. As transportation is typically a barrier for students who live in underserved areas – Don knew it was essential to make this accommodation.

After months of preparation and chasing donors, SCSO was able to provide a fully-funded holiday concert to 2300 students at Sacramento Memorial Auditorium. With the incredible support of volunteers, staff and partners – Kendrick conducted a holiday concert and puppet show with the Sacramento Choral Society & Orchestra and Green Valley Theater Company. During the performance, students, teachers, and parents were invited to sing along to holiday carols including "Jingle Bells," "The Grinch" and many more! The energy in the room on that day was unforgettable – and we owe it all to Don Kendrick for having the vision, artistry and persistence to make it a reality.

Kendrick looks forward to providing even more students this experience in 2020! Want to see Kendrick in action? Catch him on May 9 at Sacramento Memorial Auditorium for SCSO's concert performance of "Rodgers and Hammerstein," featuring songs from popular Broadway hits and classic musicals. 

How She Came to Co-own


Skin Care Advice

ZUPPA TOSCANA

Zuppa Toscana

Ingredient

1 pound hot Italian sausage (removed from casing)
Half of a medium yellow onion, diced
3 medium Yukon gold potatoes, diced
1-12 ounce can of fire-roasted tomatoes
32 ounces chicken broth or bone broth
Garlic powder

Salt + pepper

1 bunch of kale - rinsed & chopped

 ${\bf Optional:}$

 $Lemon\ juice$

Parmesan cheese

In a large pot or skillet on medium heat, brown the sausage, breaking it apart with a wooden spoon. Remove sausage from pan & sauté onions about 2 minutes, until soft.

In large pot, add browned sausage, onions, diced potatoes, fire-roasted tomatoes, broth and bring to a boil. Season with salt, pepper and garlic powder to taste. When the soup has come to a boil, turn off the heat & add the kale. The heat from the soup cooks the kale perfectly. Once served, I like to finish it off with a little bit of fresh lemon juice & Parmesan cheese.

This can easily be made in the **instant pot** as well. I brown the meat, sauté the onions and add all the ingredients, up to the kale, set the instant pot to the 'soup' function and it's done in 15 minutes. After pressure is released, add the kale & serve.
